



## 2022 COVID19 RESPONSE PLAN

### ✓ Arrival/Dismissal

- It is critical that a staff or student does not report to UU if they are not feeling well or experiencing the following symptoms: fever, cough, sore throat, body aches, fatigue, loss of taste or smell, difficulty breathing. Any staff or student who exhibits any of these symptoms or with a temperature of 100.4 or greater will be sent home immediately.
- Face masks are not required. Wearing of face masks is at the discretion of each adult participant or student's parent/legal guardian. (UU will have face masks available at no charge for those who wish to wear one.)

### ✓ Safety Actions During Course/Workshop

- Course/Workshop groups will stay consistent throughout each session with the same number of students and mentors.
- Handwashing by students and mentors will be done frequently throughout the session. Hand sanitizer will also be available and students are welcome to carry their own personal hand sanitizer if desired.
- An isolation area will be established for any student who begins to exhibit symptoms during the session to ensure their separation from other students and mentors until the time they are picked up by designated parent or guardian.

### ✓ Follow Up Cleaning

- Erie City Mission will follow CDC guidelines on cleaning and disinfecting the various types of surfaces that students and mentors may contact following each day's session. We will also frequently clean high-touch areas throughout the day.
- CDC protocols for cleaning and disinfecting after any suspected or confirmed case of COVID-19 will be observed.
